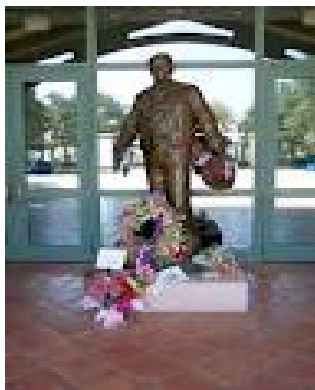
FEBRUARY—LOS ANGELES NOSTALGIA **Wednesday, February 29, 2012**

You'll be amazed with the Los Angeles treasures from yesteryear that will be showcased today. Highlights include visits inside the Biltmore Hotel, Union Station, Grand Central Market, the Bradbury Building (pending filming), the Garment District, California Plaza, and Olvera Street.



Also included is a ride on the recently re-opened Angels Flight, known as the shortest railway in the world. MARCH—THE "NEW" REAGAN LIBRARY **With Included Barbecue Lunch & George Washington Exhibit** **Tuesday, March 13, 2012**



You are cordially invited to a memorable day at the state-of-the-art, newly renovated, Ronald Reagan Presidential Library and Museum. In honor of Ronald Reagan's 100th Birthday in 2011, the Library underwent an extensive remodel and now features 26,000 square feet of new interactive exhibits and never-before-seen presidential artifacts. A docent-guided tour of the museum will revisit the 1980s and the world that Reagan shaped during his eight years in the White House. Learn about events that molded his character, visit an exact replica of the Oval Office as it was during his administration, and reflect at his final resting place. See a piece of the Berlin Wall, immerse yourself in Camp David and Rancho del Cielo, and catch a glimpse into Ronald and Nancy's devoted marriage. A highlight of your day will be walking through Air Force One, the airplane that served Reagan throughout his presidency.

On display for only a limited time will be a special exhibit, *Discover the Real George Washington: New Views from Mount Vernon*. Approximately 100 original objects associated with George Washington – including the only surviving complete set of his famous dentures – will be on display.
